

Bathroom Cleaning Supplies Toilet brush and bowl cleaner

Spray bottle with tub & tile cleaner

Clean rags or paper towel

Microfiber cloth to polish and shine

Vacuum

Rubber gloves Stiff brush

Steam or microfiber mop

Remove

Bath mats or rugs
Anything on countertops
Dirty laundry
Wastebasket (and empty it!)

Spray

Apply your preferred cleaning product to areas that need to be cleaned. Let it soak in while you clean other areas.

Sinks

Bathtub

Shower

Toilet

Wipe

Use a rag or sponge to work from ceiling to floor, wiping down all surfaces in the bathroom (except the mirror and toilet).

Light fixtures

Vent fans

Curtain rods

Shower fixtures

Sink faucets

Vanity & countertops

Scrub

Return to areas that you previously sprayed and use a sponge or a stiff brush to remove soap scum and mildew. Rinse with clean water or rinse your sponge in the sink as you scrub.

Shower walls

Bathtub

Shower door glass

Toilet

Floor

Vacuum the floor and bathmats. Use a steam mop or microfiber mop with disinfectant to finish.

Shine

It's the details that make a difference. Finish up with a dry rag; buff and shine everything!

Drain caps

Handles & knobs

Mirror
