Removal Methods

- 1 Launder with hot water
- 2 Launder with cold water
- 3 Flush back side with cold water
- 4 Flush back side with hot water
- 5 Flush with hydrogen peroxide
- 6 Pretreat with stain remover
- 8 Rub the stain together with the fabric
- 10 Blot with rubbing alcohol

Common Stain Removal Mixtures

Dish soap solution:

1 tablespoon dish soap, 10 ounces water

Vinegar solution: 1 cup white vinegar, 1 cup water

Ammonia solution:

1 cup ammonia, 1 cup water
